## AS BY A NEW PENTECOST

## Olympic Motto - *Citius, Altius, Fortius*

Prague Archbishop Dominik Cardinal Duka celebrated a mass in English in Sochi on the first day of the Winter Olympics for participants in the event, at the initiative of the Czech Olympic Committee. Cardinal Duka has already pointed out that the Olympic motto *Citius, Altius, Fortius* (Faster, Higher, Stronger) has its origin from the Catholic Church. The motto was adopted in 1894 by Baron Pierre de Coubertin, the modern Olympic Games' founder, from his friend Father Henri Didon, a passionate athlete.



## A SPIRITUAL BOUQUET FOR FATHER AU

In celebration of the 16<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Father Richard Au's ordination, the Legion of Mary has initiated a Spiritual Bouquet for Father. All parishioners at St. Joseph's as well as your family and friends are invited to join. A sign-up sheet can be found at the entrance of the church.

A "spiritual bouquet" is not a bouquet of flowers but rather a selection of special prayers or acts of devotion dedicated to the person you are giving it to. The idea is that each prayer is like a flower and that the group is like a bouquet mystically offered as a gift to God for a particular intention, e.g. for the intentions of the Pope in honor of his birthday or for a priest's ordination anniversary. Those who participate promise a certain amount of prayers and devotions for the intention and then the list is compiled and given to the person whose intentions are being remembered in prayer.
