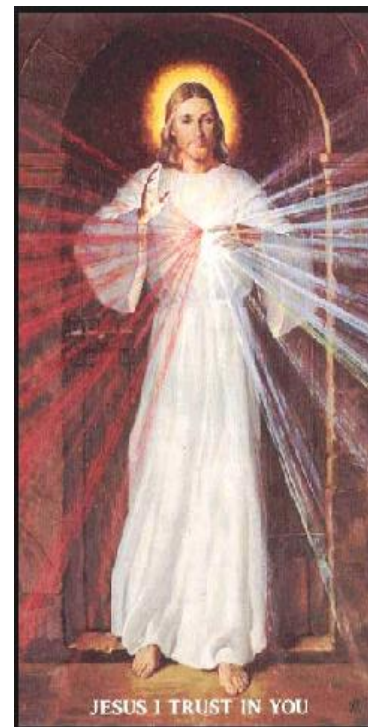
## PRAYERS FOR PRIESTS

## The Feast of Mercy The New Plenary Indulgence

During the course of Jesus' revelations to St. Faustina on the Divine Mercy, He asked on numerous occasions that a feast day be dedicated to the Divine Mercy and that this feast be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. The liturgical texts of that day, the Second Sunday of Easter, concern the Institution of the Sacrament of Penance, the Tribunal of Divine Mercy, and are thus already suited to the request of our Lord. This Feast, which had already been granted to the nation of Poland and has been celebrated within the Vatican City, was granted to the Universal Church by Pope John Paul II on the occasion of the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000. In a decree dated May 23, 2000, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments stated that "throughout the world the Second Sunday of Easter will receive the name Divine Mercy Sunday, a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind will experience in the years to come." The Papal acts represent the highest endorsement that the Church can give to a private revelation, an act of Papal Infallibility proclaiming the certain sanctity of St. Faustina and the credibility of the Divine Mercy devotion.

Today, on Divine Mercy Sunday, Popes John XXIII and John Paul II will be canonized in Rome, and the Archdiocese of Vancouver is celebrating in a big way at PNE's Pacific Coliseum, starting at 2pm. Archbishop Miller and Canada's new Nuncio Archbishop Luigi Bonazzi attending, with combined choir from all nine Catholic high schools. Special devotion to the Divine Mercy will take place as we pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet together. **Be sure to bring your rosary.** If you have received a ticket but are no longer able to attend, please be sure to pass your ticket to a friend. 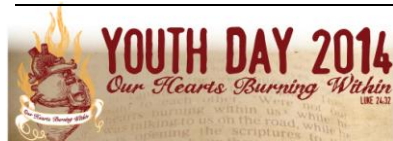
**SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL**

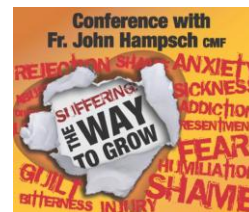
