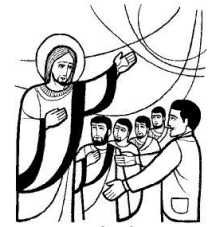

ELECTIONS FOR ARCHBISHOP CARNEY SCHOOL EDUCATION COMMITTEE

ACRSS Education Committee Election is at the end of May. St. Joseph's Parish has one elected position to be filled for the coming two years. If you are interested in putting your name forward for elections, please pick up Nomination Form and Letter of 'Expectations...' from the parish office. Deadline for the completed form must be submitted to the parish office, no later than Sun., May 25, 2014. Please see the following Archdiocesan policy for those who are eligible to nominate and/or hold office:

ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION (HOLD OFFICE): Those eligible to hold office as a member of a school education committee are practicing Catholics (meaning those who go to Mass every Sunday), approved by the Pastor, who are eligible to vote in that parish and have reached the age of twenty-one (21). The candidate must be a registered parishioner of St. Joseph's Parish.

NON-ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION: teachers and principal of the school; past employees of the school until three full calendar years have passed since the termination of employment; employees of the school; spouses, children, parents, brothers and sisters of persons covered in the above; all other teachers/principals employed currently working for the CISVA.

This month's movie '**Messenger of the Truth**'

is a remarkable true story of a Solidarity era martyr, Blessed Fr. Jerzy Popiełuszko. This film is a must see documentary for all who believe in the rights of Religious Liberty, the dignity of the human person, and those who are lovers of freedom and defenders of the truth."

Popiełuszko's sermons were routinely broadcast by [Radio Free Europe](http://RadioFreeEurope.com), and thus became famous throughout Poland for their uncompromising stance against the regime. The Służba Bezpieczeństwa tried to silence and intimidate him. When those techniques did not work, they fabricated evidence against him; he was arrested in 1983, but soon released on intervention of the clergy and pardoned by an amnesty.

Watch this powerful movie of a modern day martyr defending his faith and the freedom of his countrymen.
