WARM WEATHER DAYS ARE HERE AGAIN!!



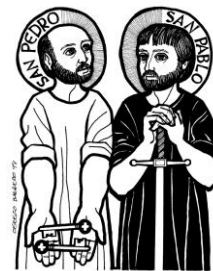
