~ 15th Anniversary at a special 11 am Mass on June 13, 2014~
(Feast of St. Anthony)

All seniors and those who are gravely ill are invited to receive the healing touch of Jesus.

Weakened by age and different ailments, the Lord wants to make sure that you are not suffering your grave situation alone. He wants to use this Sacrament to support you in this time of difficulty. Anyone who is going through life threatening surgeries should receive this sacrament. Obviously, this sacrament is not just for any normal conditions of cold or flu, nor even re-occurring sickness that are not life-threatening. It can be also for young and old who are going to have a surgery which is very serious.

With Jesus on our side, it is consoling to know that we can fight a good fight. A free luncheon will be provided as like previous years after this special Mass. Also, some of our young people from our parish will be serving this wonderful luncheon.

God's blessings to all who help to co-ordinate this event, especially those volunteers who help the physically infirm to this special occasion.

"The special grace of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick has as its effects: the uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his own good and that of the whole Church; the strengthening, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age; the forgiveness of sins, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of penance; the restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his soul; the preparation for passing over to eternal life" (CCC 1532). By enduring suffering courageously, one gains sanctification and helps others.
