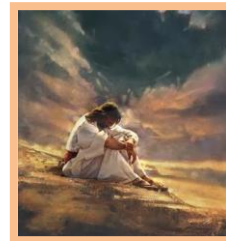

## What to Do in A Lonely Place

"And in the morning, a great while before day, he rose and went out to a lonely place, and there he prayed."

Mark 1:35

How do you begin your day? Our Lord, early in the morning, sought out a lonely place to pray. He spent time in solitude in fellowship with the Father. He found renewal, refreshment, and was able to seek the Father's direction for the strenuous duties which awaited him that day. It was Jesus' custom to pray alone early each day. In that activity, he set an important example for us. To be alone with God at the beginning of each day is to find renewal and empowerment for the challenges we will meet from hour to hour. The promise of the Scripture is this: "Things beyond our seeing, things beyond our hearing things beyond our imagining all prepared by God for those who love him: these it is that God has revealed to us through the Spirit." 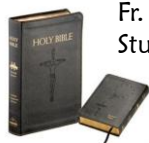
