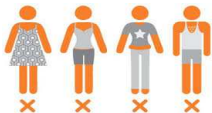

August 6th ~ The Transfiguration of the Lord

And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem. Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. As they were about to part from him, Peter said to Jesus, 'Master, it is good that we are here; . . .'" (Lk 9:28-33).

Through the reception of Eucharist at Mass, we are transfigured with the light of Christ, though it is hidden within us, that we may one day be fully enveloped in the joy of the face to face wisdom of God.

CHABC Annual Conference

The annual conference of the Catholic Health Association of B. C. will be held on Sept. 17th at the Executive Plaza Hotel in Coquitlam. Our theme this year is "Understanding the Moral, Ethical and Practical Complexities of Assisted Suicide". Our speakers include internationally renowned ethicist Margaret Somerville from McGill University, José Pereira, Palliative Care Physician from Ottawa and Drs. David Unger and Romaine Gallagher from Providence Health Care in Vancouver. The day will begin with Mass celebrated by Archdiocesan Vicar for Health Care, Monsignor Bernard Rossi. The Supreme Court of Canada decided in February that our country's laws must change to legalize assisted suicide.
