## Hear His call

We all have heard Jesus' call to Peter, "Feed my sheep." And subconsciously each of us breathes a sigh of relief that the call was not for us. Jesus obviously meant just Peter, not even the other disciples, right?

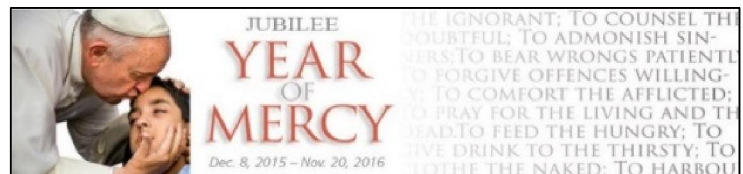
