All children 4-8 years of age, sit with their parents and will be called up after the Collect (opening prayer) and then will be led out and assembled in the portable for their liturgy.



A different kind of glory

When we think of glory, we often think of something splashy and bright. The last thing we would think of is a cross. Yet that is exactly what Jesus tells us in today's reading. The glory of God is the cross of Christ. In the cross, Jesus shares his peoples struggles through the hurricanes of life. In the cross, Jesus stands in the cloud of suffering with us.
