

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)




Primarily RCIA is for those seeking to become Catholic, or those seeking full communion with the Catholic Church. Also, it is for the adult

The program takes place every Tuesday at 7:40 pm. For more information please call the parish office.


CATHOLICISM A Journey To The Heart Of Faith
