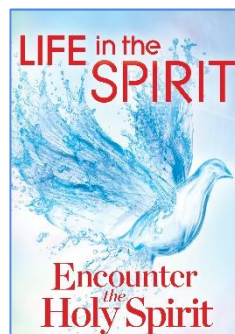
Go fish
