YOUR CHILD'S BAPTISM

Baptism is the beginning of the life of faith. Through the water of baptism your child will be "born again." He/she will be set free from original sin and enter into eternal relationship with God the Father, through Jesus Christ our Saviour. He/she will also become part of the Roman Catholic Church.

Baptism, of course, is only the beginning of this new life. For infant baptism to make sense, parents must be committed to raise their child in the faith. A child needs to be nourished into Christian faith through weekly attendance at Mass, through religious instruction, through prayer and through the example of a Christian family life. This is the commitment the Church expects of every parent who brings in a child for baptism.

PARENTS' COMMITMENT

It is assumed that the parents of children to be baptized in the parish are: attending Sunday Mass regularly; married in the Catholic Church: and registered members of St. Joseph's Parish. If this is not your situation, special arrangements must be made with the priest.

MAKING THE ARRANGEMENTS

After filling out the baptism form and returning it to the parish office, the pastor will contact you for an interview. Baptism dates will be arranged with the pastor.

SPONSOR

At least one of the baptismal sponsors must be a practicing Roman Catholic. A non-Catholic baptized Christian may stand a Christian witness. The responsibilities for the sponsor(s) for the baptized children are the same as for the parents.

BAPTISM DAY

Make it a big celebration! Invite family and friends. If you wish, take photos. Afterwards put on a party. Celebrate your child's baptismal anniversary every year. Use the baptismal candle at the celebration.

GODPARENTS - SPONSORS

One sponsor, not less than sixteen years of age, male or female, is sufficient; but there may be two, one of each sex. The sponsors role is together with the parents, to present the child for Baptism and to help the child live a Christian life befitting the baptized and to fulfill the duties inherent in Baptism.

The sponsor(s) must be a Catholic who has been confirmed and received the Blessed Eucharist, and who live a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken.
