News from the Laudato Si' Circle.

Thank you to everyone who helped to make Car Free Sunday a success once again. This is our second annual Car Free Sunday, taking place during Laudato Si' Week, which this year coincided with Pentecost Sunday.

Compared with our baseline year, 2022: the number of people using cars, including passengers, fell from 89% to 84%, of which the number of car drivers fell from 52% to 41%. The number of people using other forms of transport increased from 11% to 16% and of these, the number walking decreased from 6% to 5% but the number using public transport increased from 5% to 12%

You may have read in the local news that the Sue Big Oil Campaign in Port Moody that we have been leading has been a success. This began with a promotion at St. Joseph's Church on the first Sunday of Advent 2023. We then presented a delegation to Port Moody City Council which was accepted at a council meeting on 23rd April 2024. The mayor of Port Moody issued a public statement on 23rd May 2024 to state that Port Moody will join the class action lawsuit against the major oil companies, whereby the full costs for climate change mitigation and adaption will no longer be borne solely by Port Moody residents, but that oil companies will pay their fair share, based on their contribution to climate change. This Sue Big Oil campaign is endorsed by the Laudato Si' Movement at the national level. For more details see suebigoil.ca.
